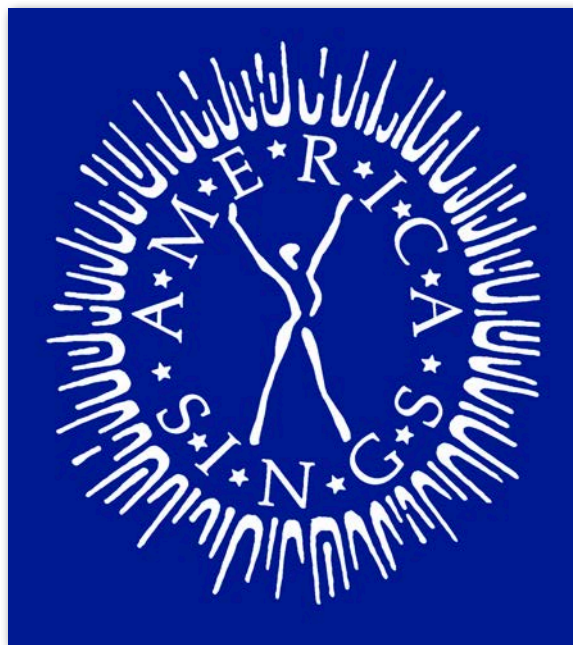

Since 1989, America Sings! hosts non-competitive choral events throughout our nation and abroad. As of 2020, nearly 300,000 singers from kindergarten through high school have participated in our events from "sea to shining sea." Our mission is simple, to provide high quality music festivals that in turn provide community service opportunities for our young singers. America Sings! Inc. was founded in 1989 by John Jacobson and a group of his friends who supported John's dream of hosting a non-competitive, outdoor choral festival. Inspired by the philanthropy of professional musicians, John knew that young amateur singers could also make a positive difference in their communities and would have a good time doing it!

After the first festival in Washington DC, America Sings! was determined to reach even more singers by creating opportunities for them to combine music and charitable service. America Sings!, a 501c3 charitable non-profit corporation, expanded its operations to produce festivals and special events in cities across America. Singers from all fifty states have attended America Sings! events and have completed community service projects to help charities in the cities where the events are held as well as in their hometowns. They donate tons of goods to food banks, homeless shelters, soup kitchens, programs for children who are sick, hospitalized or in child care centers. They donate funds to the America Sings! Share the Hope Fund which is given to recognized charities benefiting disadvantaged children.

- To promote and stimulate interest in choral music as an art form among young people and the general public as a whole.

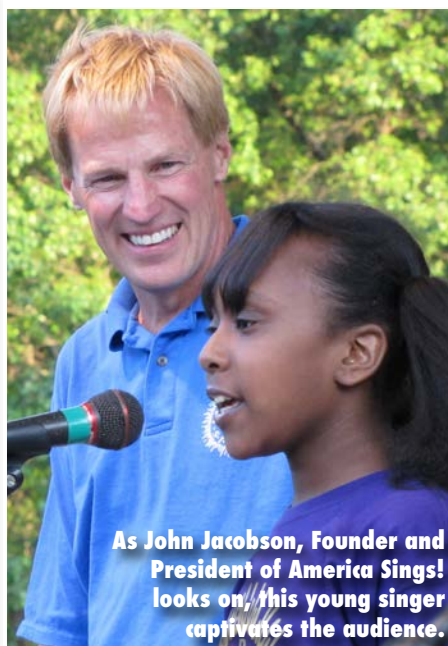


An amazing stage view of 2000 singers performing on the National Mall for our 25th anniversary .

President and Founder of America Sings!

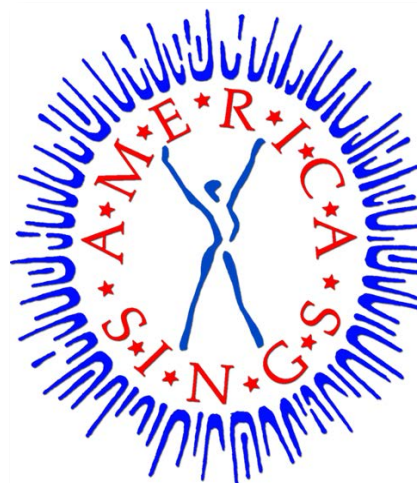
